Assessment Methodology

- Mission Composition:
- 4 International staff
- 10 National staff
- Based on FAO/ILO Livelihood Toolkit and in line with government strategies.
- Assessment focused on 4 sectors;
- Crops; Livestock; Fisheries and Forestry

Main Findings

- CROPS
- Vegetable Seeds
- Rice Seeds (Aus season in February 2008)
- Rice Seeds (Amon season in June 2008)
- Pulses (Mungbean, groundnut, Grass Peas)
- Mineral Fertilizer for the Rice Crops and Organic fertilizer for the Vegetables.
- ICM Clubs reorganization and empowerment.
- Horticulture Farmers support with Seedlings, etc.

Main Findings

- Fishery
- Inputs to Shrimp farms (Lime, fertilizer, fry and feed)
- Inputs to Carp farms (Lime, fertilizer, fry and feed)
- Food For Work (labour support);
- Provide boats and fishing gears to reorganized fisherfolks.

Main Findings

- Livestock
- Emergency provision of feed for cattle and goats;
- Restocking (areas not affected by Avian Influenza)
- Provision of Veterinary Drugs; Vitamins,

Main Findings

- Forestry and Sundarbans
- Establish Socio-forestry biodiversity monitoring system;
- Repair damaged infrastructure including embankments and replant them with trees;
- Establish home based tree and horticulture nurseries for women, and capacity building for forestry and sundarban staff;
