

HPAI update as of 10 June

- Increase in number of affected districts from 2 to 12 between 05/02 to 08/06

[Jamalpur, Dhaka, Gazipur, Naryangonj, Tangail, Gaibandha, Jessore, Noakhali, Magura, Rajbari, Nilfamari, Dinajpur]

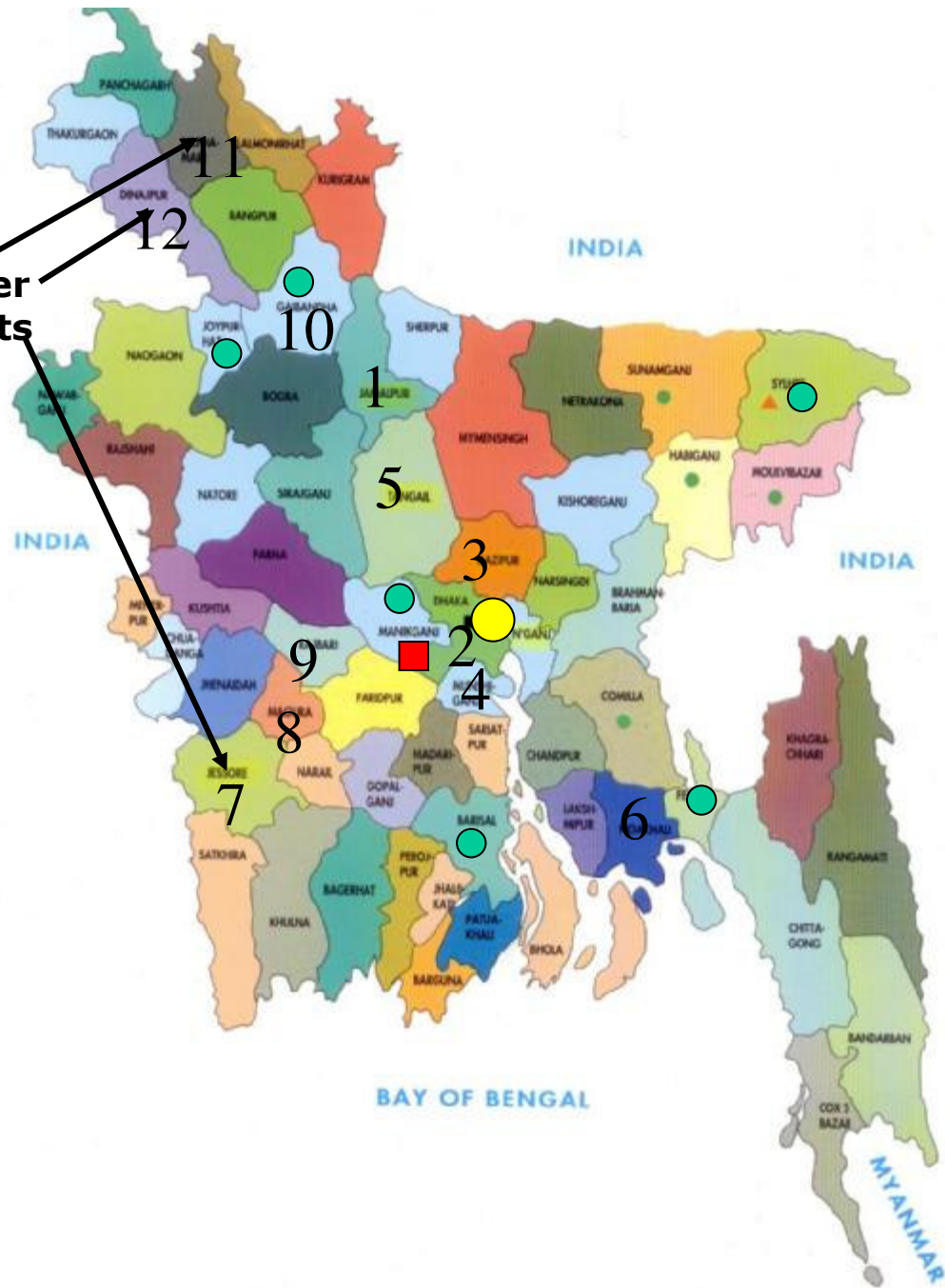
- Increase in number of farms from 2 affected farms (outbreaks) to 41 farms between 05/02 to 08/06
- Total birds culled so far are 1,48,532 [62 farms]
- There is no official report on the number of birds died
