Weather and Flood Situation

Weather Warning

Due to strong monsoon deep convection is taking place over North Bay. Steep pressure gradient lies over North Bay. Squally weather may affect North Bay and the maritime ports and adjoining coastal area of Bangladesh.

Maritime ports of Chittagong, Cox’s Bazar and Mongla have been advised to hoist local cautionary signal number three (r) three.

All fishing boats and trawlers over North Bay have been advised to come close to the coast and proceed with caution till further notice.

Synoptic Situation: Monsoon axis runs through Rajshtan, Hariyana, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal thence Northeast wards to Assam across central part of Bangladesh. One of its associated trough extends to Northwest Bay. Monsoon is active over Bangladesh and strong elsewhere over North Bay.

Forecast: Light to moderate rain/T.showers accompanied by tempo. gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at most places over Dhaka, Khulna, Barisal, Chittagong & Sylhet divisions and at many places over Rajshahi & Rangpur divisions with heavy to very heavy falls at places.

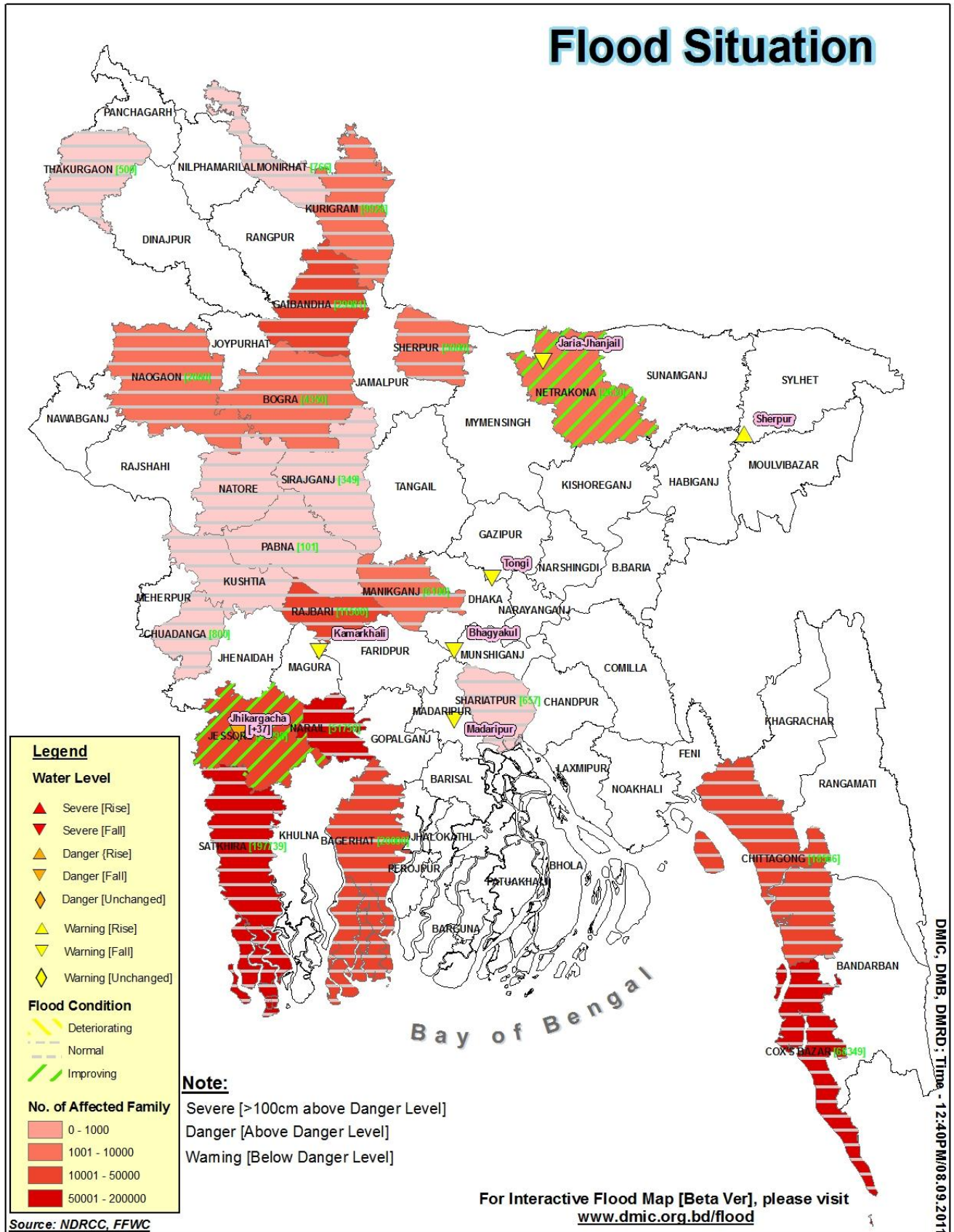
