**Summary of Cyclone Sidr Response**

Updated official report from MoFDM illustrates that the number of death caused by tropical cyclone 'SIDR' has risen to **3246 affecting 8.0 million** people of **1.9 million** families. These casualties and damages of houses, livestock, crops, educational institutions, roads and embankments have been reported from 1867 unions of 200 upazilas of 30 districts. Most deaths and damages have been attributed to the storm surge.

AFD is working on non-stop basis and carrying the relief goods to the local administrations, communities at the very remote locations by both BAF and US Aircrafts. Today 07 air sorties were carried out by BAF with 21.38 tonnes of relief goods. **Up to 27 November 2007 they have carried 783 tonnes relief items by 165 sorties.**

US army is purifying 15,200 gallon water per day for drinking by their water purifying plant built in the Kearsarge for distribution to remote areas. Lt. Col. J. Reagan expressed their satisfaction about the coordination among Bangladesh Army, Bangladesh Gov. and themselves at the press briefing.

Up to Tuesday, November 27, 2007 GoB have allocated approx 502 million BDT from Honorable Chief Advisor's Relief & Welfare Fund and DRR, MoFDM for the Sidr victims. GoB has also allocated 10890 MT GR Rice, distributed 27,000 food bags, 26700 blankets, 16454 tents, 3,348 utensils and 13,000 bundles of CI sheets by the Directorate of Relief and Rehabilitation (DRR).

### Actions Taken:

- A meeting was held in MoFDM at 11:00 am today for international assistance coordination chaired by the Honourable Advisor, MoFDM. Cyclone Sidr disaster situation was updated by the Secretary in-Charge, MoFDM, and remarks were made by UN Resident Coordinator. Commitments and clarifications were made by donors at this meeting and strategies taken to ensure food security.
- 2nd meeting was held in MoFDM at 3:00 pm today with international and national NGOs on cyclone Sidr response and recovery. In this meeting, GoB and NGO representatives had discussions on coordination at the national and local level. Strategic plan of action was also discussed in the meeting.
- 03 Relief receiving cells have been established to receive relief goods from individuals/organisations at Directorate of Relief and Rehabilitation, Dhaka Zila Parishad and Regional Public Administration Center.
- DMIC hosted 2<sup>nd</sup> Information Management Coordination Meeting at CDMP conference room today where GoB, WFP, UNICEF, IBM, ALDA, OCHA, CEGIS and many others were present. The Information Management Coordination Team will again at DMIC next week.
- IBM supplied and installed High-end IBM Server (Unix Based) at the Disaster Management Bureau (DMB) for emergency information management. They also provided opensource disaster information management portal suite SAHANA.

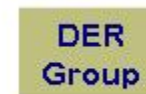
