Summary of Cyclone Sidr Response

Updated official report from MoFDM illustrates that the number of death caused by tropical cyclone 'SIDR' has risen to **3295 affecting 8.7 million** people of **2.0 million** families. These casualties and damages of houses, livestock, crops, educational institutions, roads and embankments have been reported from **1896** unions of 200 upazilas of 30 districts. Most deaths and damages have been attributed to the storm surge.

AFD is working on non-stop basis and carrying the relief goods to the local administrations, communities at the very remote locations by both BAF and US Aircrafts. Today BAF carried 1500 kg relief items from Dhaka to Barisal and US carried 55811.5 kg relief items to affected areas..

Up to Tuesday, December 04, 2007 GoB have allocated approx 808 million BDT from Honorable Chief Advisor's Relief & Welfare Fund and DRR, MoFDM for the Sidr victims. GoB has also allocated 16890 MT GR Rice, distributed 27,000 food bags, 26700 blankets, 16454 tents, 3,348 carton utensils and 13,000 bundles of CI sheets by the Directorate of Relief and Rehabilitation (DRR).

Actions Taken:

- The Honorable Chief Advisor attended a meeting with the NGO representatives at his office; the secretary of the MoFDM attended the meeting too.
- The Ambassador of Srilanka handed over relief goods to the Secretary, MoFDM today at the secretary's office.
- UNHCR representative met with the secretary, MoFDM at his office today to discuss about the possible role of UNHCR in addressing the emergency response.

Situation Report

- Mr. Pius Costa, Joint Secretary to GoB has joined at Post SIDR disaster Management Coordination cell (PSDMC) as the chief of the cell along with the representatives from MoFDM, DRR, DMB and CDMP. The contact numbers of the cell is 04327-73113 and the fax number is 04327-73116.
- The first four trucks of UNICEF committed jericans were received by the coordination cell and directed to the Borguna, Bagerhat, Perojpur, Patuakhali districts.
- In Gopalganj, Madaripur and Shariatpur 196 ponds of different upazilas were cleaned by Department of Public Health Engineering and are being used for household works. Other unclean ponds are not being used.

Operations by Armed Forces Divisions (AFD)

Today BAF moved 1500 kg relief items from Dhaka to Barisal.

US transferred 50820 kg relief items by 06 C-130 and 4991.5 kg relief items by 4 helicopters. In addition to that US operated 2 helicopter missions with 1 medical team to Kolapara and sent other 2 helicopters with another medical team to Dublarchar.

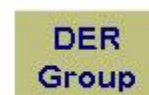

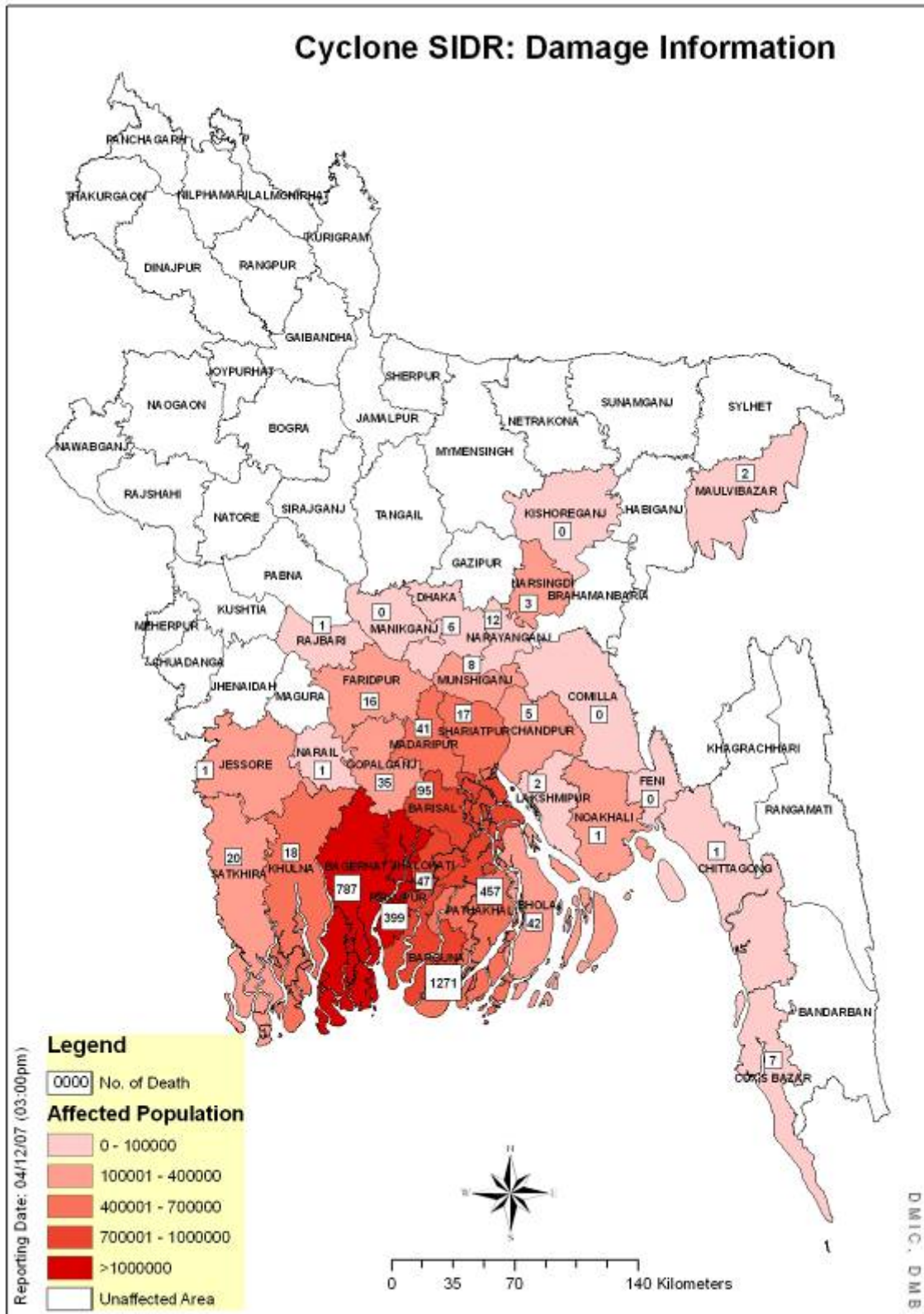

SIDR Damage

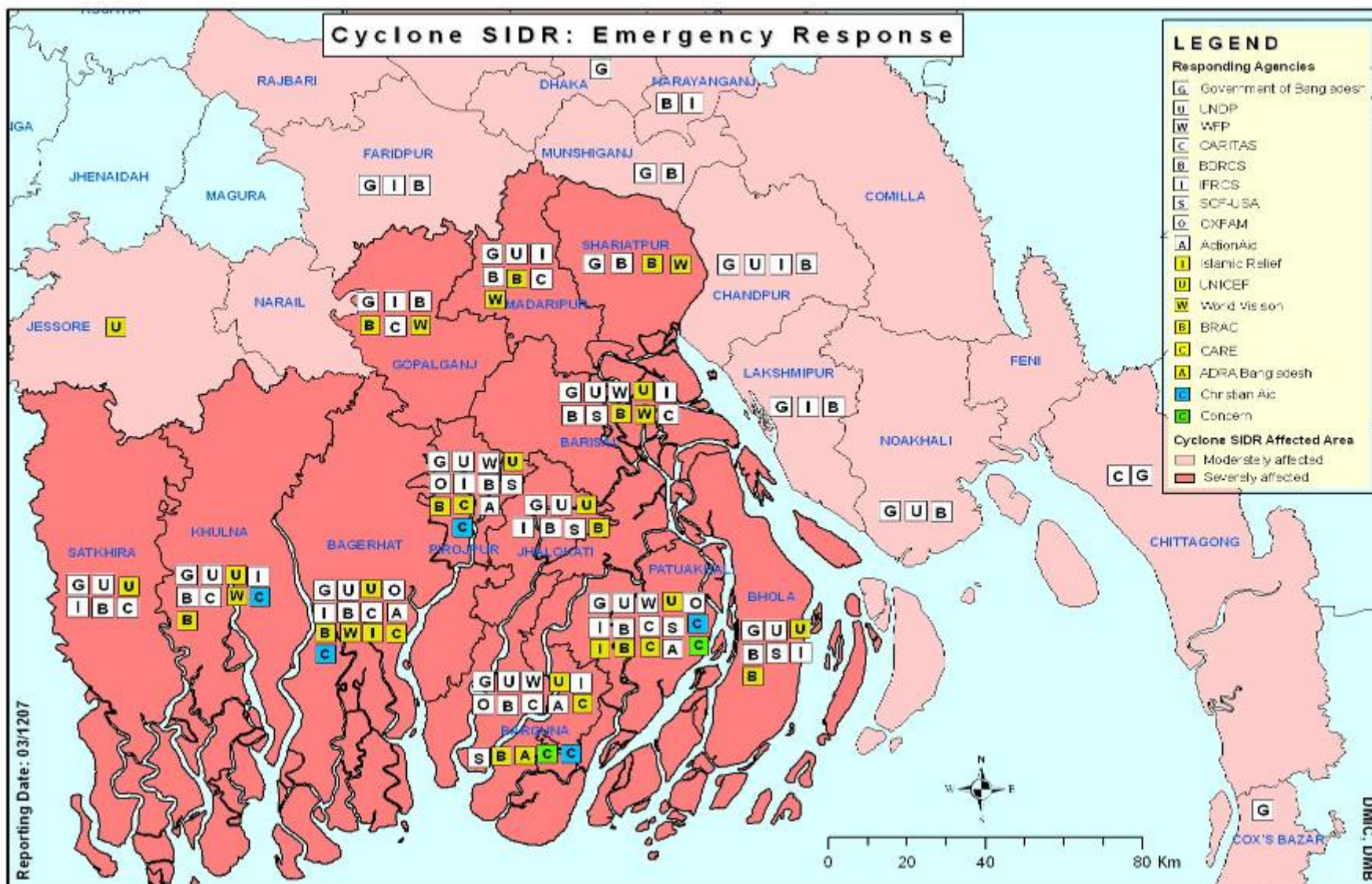


Most affected areas by Sidr
