Summary of Cyclone Sidr Response

Updated official report from MoFDM illustrates that the number of death caused by tropical cyclone 'SIDR' has risen to **3,347 affecting 8.9 million** people of **2 million** families. These casualties and damages of houses, livestock, crops, educational institutions, roads and embankments have been reported from **1,950** unions of 200 upazilas of 30 districts. Most deaths and damages have been attributed to the storm surge.

AFD is working on non-stop basis and carrying the relief goods to the local administrations, communities at the very remote locations by both BAF and US Aircrafts and also by river. Today AFD sent 100 T relief items to local administrations of affected five districts.

Up to Today, December 09, 2007 GoB has allocated approximately 1721 million BDT from Honorable Chief Advisor's Relief & Welfare Fund and DRR, MoFDM for the Sidr victims. GoB has also allocated 16890 MT GR Rice, distributed 27,000 food bags, 66,700 blankets, 16,454 tents, 3,348 carton utensils and 13,000 bundles of CI sheets by the Directorate of Relief and Rehabilitation (DRR).

Actions Taken:

- 80000 pcs jarican provided by UNICEF have been allocated for distribution to the people cyclone affected 9 districts.
- Relief materials from many institutions/individuals to RPATC, Dhaka and DRR head office (Flat rice, water, old cloths, molasses) have been transferred to Jhalokathi by one truck.
- BDT 30 Crore have been allocated to the Patuakhali and Pirojpur (15 Crore each) as a house building grant for DRR. BDT 60 crore have been allocated to Bagerhat and Borguna (30 Crore each) as a house building grant from the "**Chief Adviser's Relief and Welfare Fund**".

- BDT 10000000 have been allocated for buying for foods for mother and child and distributing to the affected areas Patuakhali, Borguna, Pirojpur and Bagerhat (BDT 250000 each).

- A meeting was held today at 11:00 am at the MoFDM on building cyclone shelters.
- An inter-ministerial meeting was held today at 3:00 pm at the MoFDM on Cyclone Sidr damage and rehabilitation report finalization.
- An ILO Mission will be visiting the cyclone affected districts of Bagerhat from December 10, 2007 to December 12, 2007 and Pirozpur from December 13, 2007 to December 15, 2007. Operations by Armed Forces Divisions (AFD)

Today AFD sent 100 T relief items to local administrations of affected five districts Bagerhat, Patuakhali, Pirojpur, Barisal and Barguna by launch.

On December 7, 2007 BAF operated one sorties C-130 to carry 7.194 T relief items to the affected areas.

BAF moved 236 kg relief items to the affected areas by Bell-212 on December 6, 2007.

On the same day US transferred 4.166 Ton relief items by 04 C-130 and 3.325 kg relief items by 02 CH-53. In addition to that US operated helicopter missions with medical teams to the affected areas.

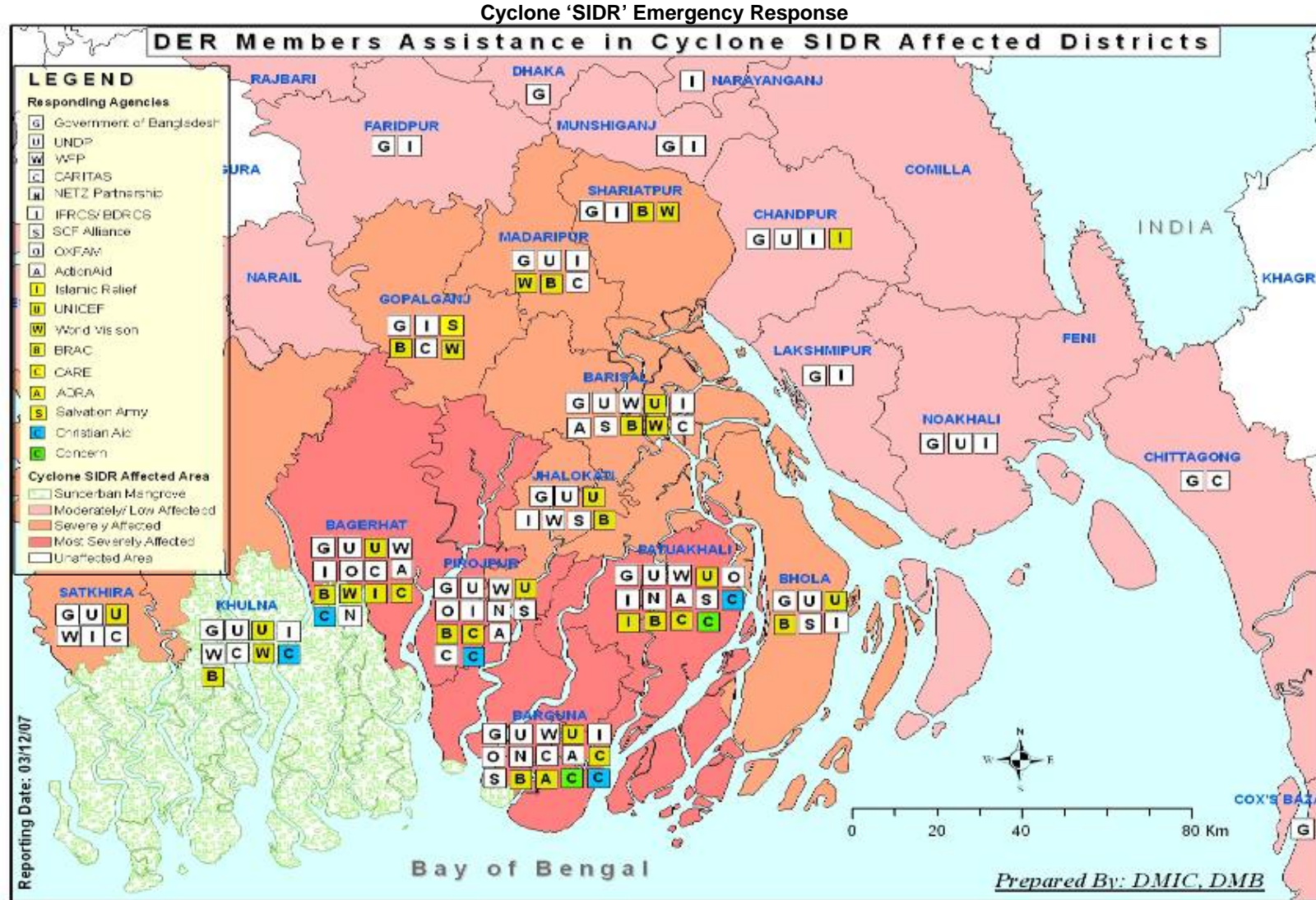
