Summary of Cyclone Sidr Response

Updated official report from MoFDM illustrates that the number of death caused by tropical cyclone 'SIDR' has risen to **3,347 affecting 8.9 million** people of **2 million** families. These casualties and damages of houses, livestock, crops, educational institutions, roads and embankments have been reported from **1,950** unions of 200 upazilas of 30 districts. Most deaths and damages have been attributed to the storm surge.

AFD is working on non-stop basis and carrying the relief goods to the local administrations, communities at the very remote locations by both BAF and US Aircrafts and also by river. Yesterday AFD sent 100 T relief items to local administrations of affected five districts.

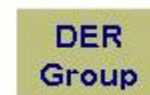
Up to Yesterday, December 09, 2007 GoB has allocated approximately 1721 million BDT from Honorable Chief Advisor's Relief & Welfare Fund and DRR, MoFDM for the Sidr victims. GoB has also allocated 16890 MT GR Rice, distributed 27,000 food bags, 66,700 blankets, 16,454 tents, 3,348 carton utensils and 13,000 bundles of CI sheets by the Directorate of Relief and Rehabilitation (DRR).

Actions Taken:

- There was a meeting today at 10:00 am in the MoFDM between the Secretary MoFDM, Dr. Ayub Miah and representatives of Kuwait Red Crescent Society. The Kuwait Red Crescent representatives expressed their interest on building of cyclone shelters and providing relief goods.
- 5th air package carrying 94 MT of food items in 4390 packets provided by the Royal Saudi Government reached Dhaka yesterday night. Received food items have been handed over to armed forces division today to send promptly to disaster areas.
- 571 packets of food items provided by the Government of Jordan reached Dhaka yesterday night and have been handed over to armed forces division today to send promptly to disaster areas.

- Bangladesh Red Crescent Society has received 10 tonnes of medicines today directly from Kuwait Red Crescent Society.
- In Patuakhali, Madaripur, Gopalganj and Shariatpur no ponds are being used as source of drinking water though 619 ponds were cleaned by Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) which are being used for household works. Another 85 ponds have been cleaned in Bagerhat (Morelganj – 8), Pirojpur (Swarupkathi – 2) and Borguna (Sadar – 39, Amtoli – 30, Bamna – 6) by DPHE for household works.
- Water is being supplied in Khulna by 38 High Density Plastic (HDP) water tanks capable of containing 500 liter of water.
- Post Sidr Relief Operation Coordination Cell (PSROCC) has been shifted to a new location. The new location of PSROCC is at the Barisal Stadium and their new Telephone No: 0431-217-6250, new fax No: 0431-217-6249.

Operations by Armed Forces Divisions (AFD)

AFD sent 100 T relief items to local administrations of affected five districts Bagerhat, Patuakhali, Pirojpur, Barisal and Barguna by Launch on December 9, 2007.

On December 7, 2007 BAF operated one sorties C-130 to carry 7.194 T relief items to the affected areas.

BAF moved 236 kg relief items to the affected areas by Bell-212 on December 6, 2007.

On the same day US transferred 4.166 Ton relief items by 04 C-130 and 3.325 kg relief items by 02 CH-53. In addition to that US operated helicopter missions with medical teams to the affected areas.

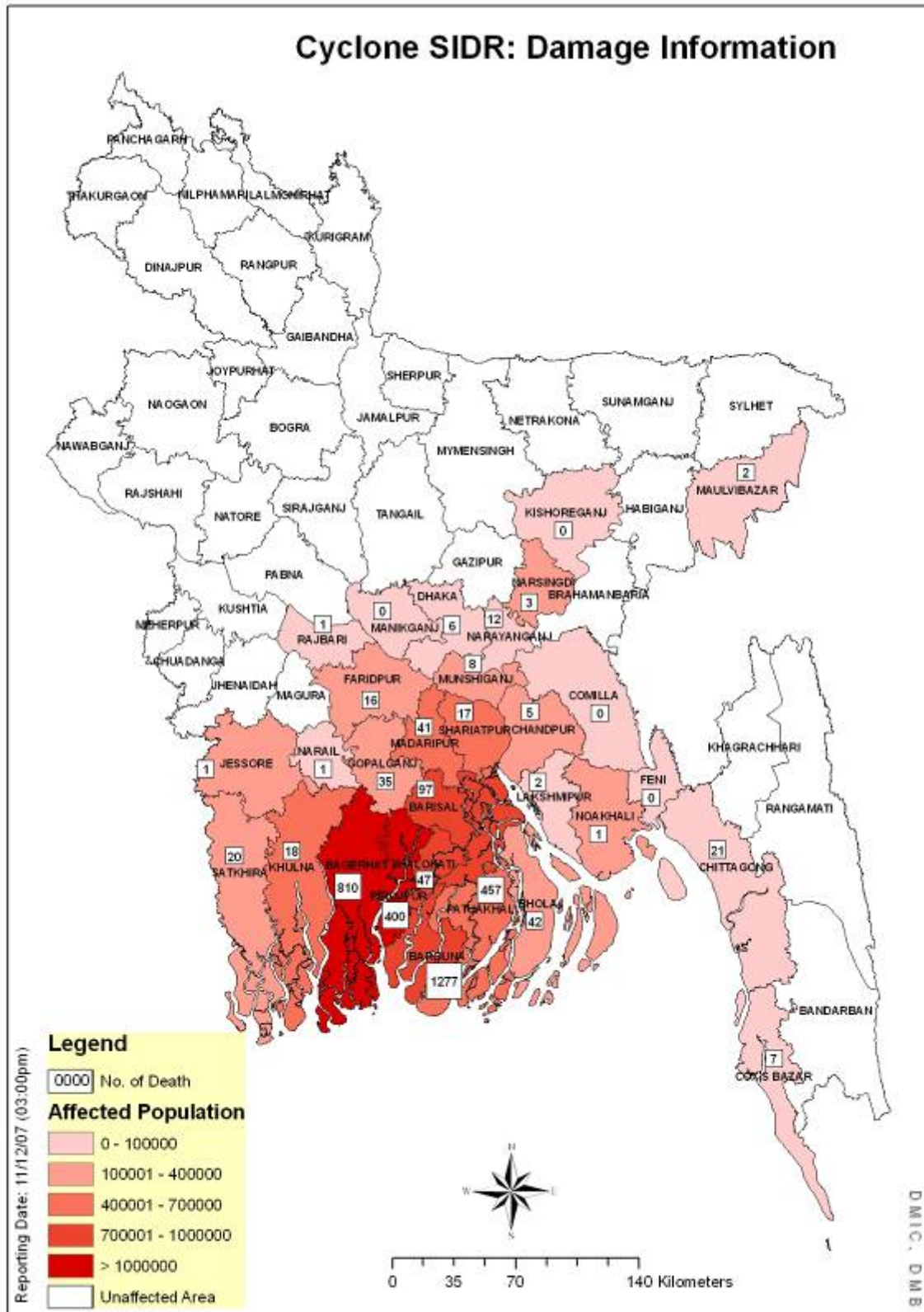

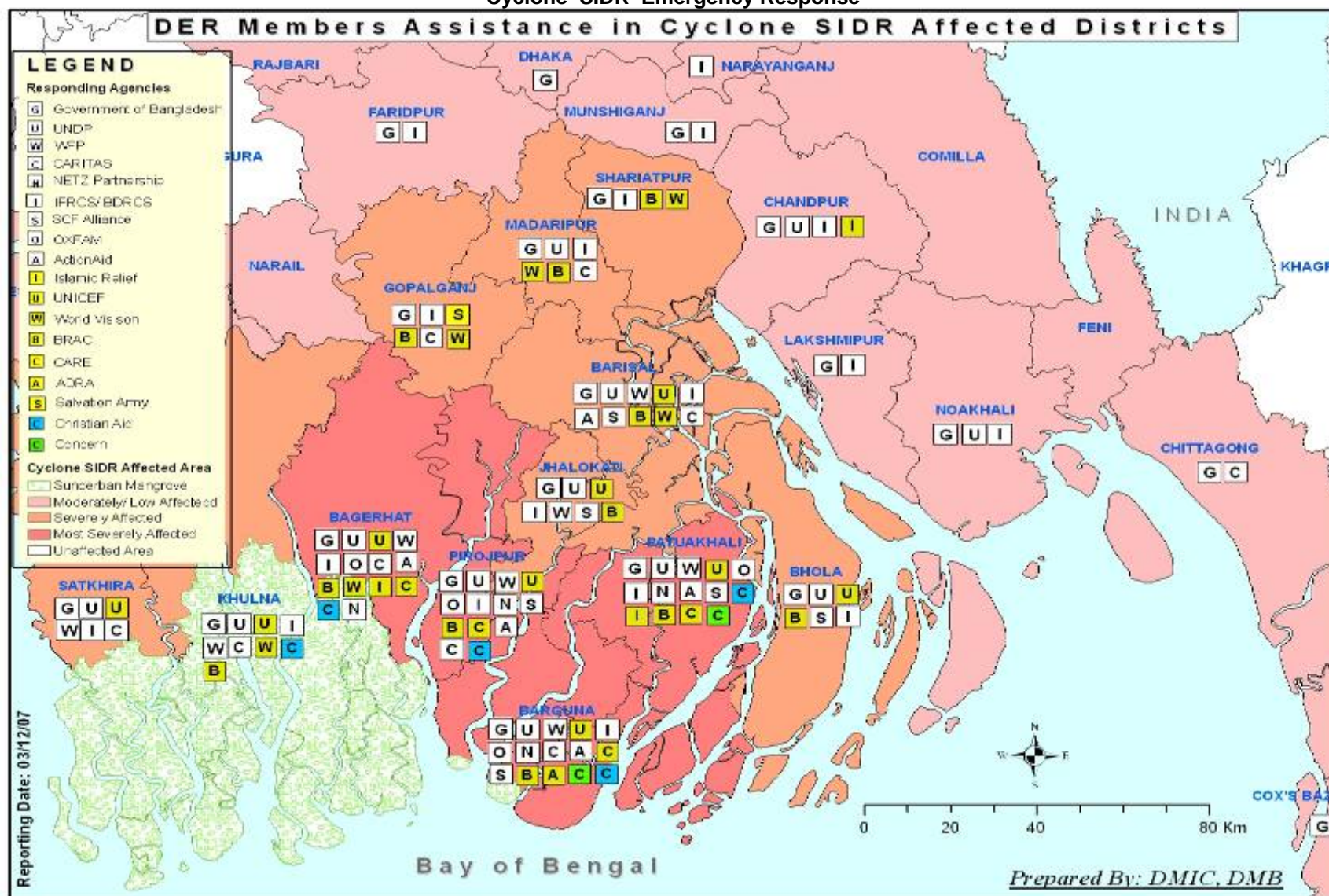


Most affected areas by Sidr

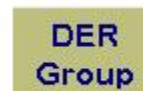
