**Public Health Situation Highlights:**

- **Highlights during last 3 days (7-9 Dec 2007) in 9 districts**

Bagerhat district has highest number of reported cases of Diarrhea, skin diseases, eye infections, pneumonia and fever / suspected typhoid.

**Public Health Intervention:**

- As of the resolution following discussions in 3<sup>rd</sup> Health Cluster Meeting, 4 sub groups has been proposed to be formed with relevant stakeholders to address issues of Disease Surveillance, Nutrition, Reproductive Health, Psychosocial / Mental Health.

The following Subgroups already held one meeting in separately with relevant partners during this reporting period i.e.

- Disease Surveillance
- Reproductive Health

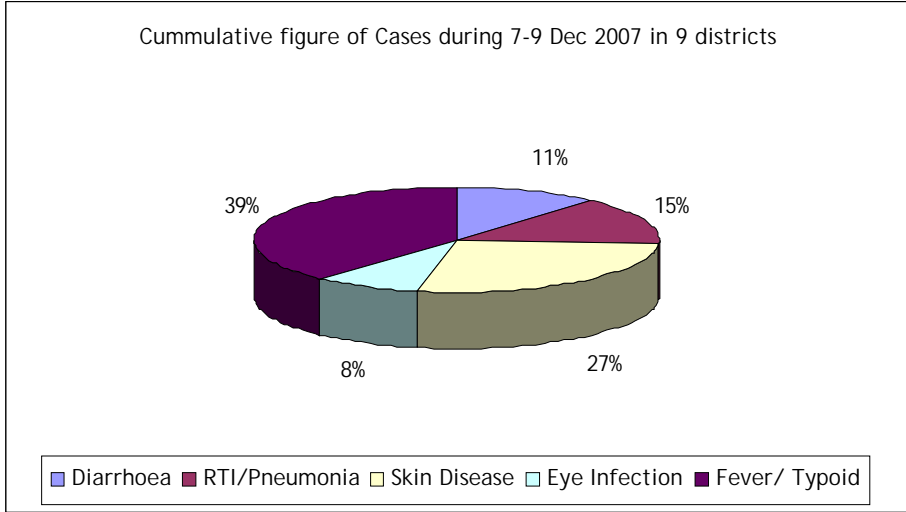
The outcome of this sub group meeting will be reported on 11 Dec 2007 to the DER Health Cluster.

- Disease Surveillance, Reproductive Health subgroups have already developed draft ToR

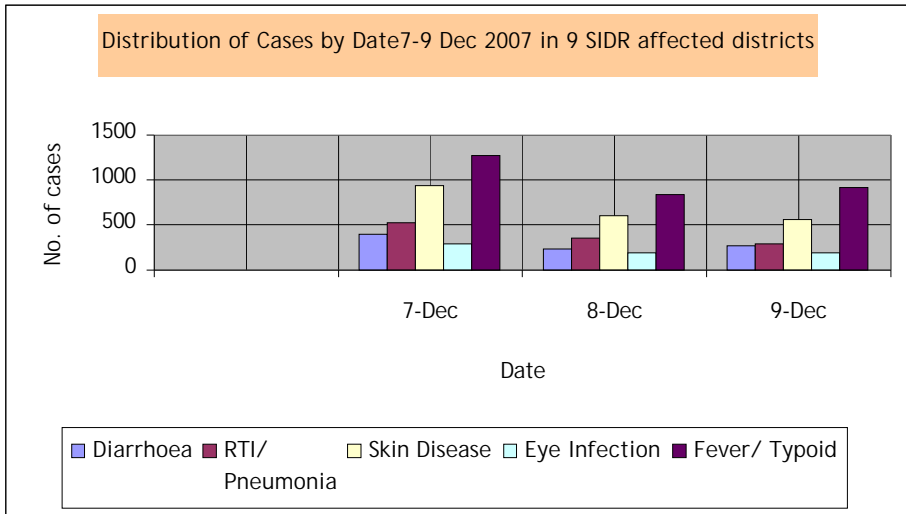
**Challenges and Priority Action:**
