Forecast Valid for 24 Hours Commencing 09 AM Today:

Synoptic Situation: The coast crossing Cyclonic Storm "AILA" moved northwards inland and completed crossing the coast of west Bengal-Khulna (Bangladesh) coast near Sagar Island of India and bay centred of Gangetic west Bengal and adjoining Bangladesh as land depression. It is likely to move in a near northerly direction further inland and weaken gradually. Steep pressure gradient lies over North Bay.

Forecast: Rain/T.showers accompanied by tempo. gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at many places over Dhaka, Rajshahi, Barisal, Khulna, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions with moderately heavy to very heavy falls at places over the country.

Day temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

Wind direction and speed at Dhaka : S/SE'ly 08-12 kph. tempo. gusting to 40-50 kph.

RH at 06 A.M. of Dhaka : 85 %

Today's sunset at Dhaka : 06-39 mts.

Tomorrow's sunrise at Dhaka : 05-11 mts.
