Forecast Valid for 24 Hours Commencing 09 AM Today:

Synoptic Situation : The well marked low over North Bay and adjoining West Bengal-Bangladesh coast moved slightly northwestwards and now lies over Northwest Bay and adjoining coastal area of West Bengal and Bangladesh. It is likely to intensify and move in a Northwesterly direction. Monsoon axis runs through Punjab, Hariyana, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal the centre of the low and thence Southeastwards. One of its associated troughs extends to Assam across central part of Bangladesh. Monsoon is fairly active over Bangladesh and strong over North Bay.

Forecast : Light to moderate rain/ thunder showers accompanied by tempo. gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at most places over Khulna, Barisal and Chittagong divisions and at many places over Rajshahi, Dhaka and Sylhet divisions with moderately heavy to heavy falls at places.

Temperature : Day temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

Wind direction / speed at Dhaka : SE/E'ly, 15-20 kph tempo. gusting to 40-50 kph.
RH at 06 AM of Dhaka : 92 %
Today's sunset at Dhaka : 06-50 mts.
Tomorrow's sunrise at Dhaka : 05-19 mts.
Outlook for next 72 hrs : Rainfall activity may increase.
