Forecast Valid for 24 Hours Commencing 09 AM Today:

Synoptic Situation: Monsoon axis runs through Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Northern parts of Bihar and West Bengal and thence Northeastwards to Assam across Northern part of Bangladesh. One of its associated trough extends to Northwest Bay. Monsoon is fairly active over Bangladesh and moderate elsewhere over North Bay

Forecast: Light to moderate rain/T. showers accompanied by tempo. gusty wind is likely to occur at many places over Dhaka, Barisal, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions and at a few places over Rajshahi and Khulna divisions with moderately heavy falls at places.

Day temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

Wind direction and speed at Dhaka: SW/S'yly 08-12 Kph tempo. gusting to 30-40 Kph.
RH at 06 A.M. of Dhaka: 92 %
