RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON JULY 07, 2008.

OUTLOOK

- *All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels except the Kangsha at Jariajanjail.*

RAINFALL

- Significant rainfalls recorded during last 24 hrs. ending at 6 AM today are:
Barguna: 127.2 mm, Satkhira: 62.4 mm, Barisal: 61.0mm, Patuakhali: 60.8 mm, Chittagong: 47.0 mm.

GENERAL RIVER CONDITION

- Water Level stations: 73, ***Above danger level:1***, Rise: 45, Fall: 26, Steady: 2, Not reported: 0.
- The rivers in the Brahmaputra & the Meghna basins observed both rise & fall while the rivers in the Ganges basin observed mostly rise and all the rivers in the South Eastern Hill basin observed fall.

BRAHMAPUTRA BASIN

- The Dharla at Kurigram observed rise by 10 cm.
- The Teesta at Dalia observed fall by 10 cm.
- The Brahmaputra-Jamuna recorded fall by 2 cm at Noonkhawa while it observed rise by 10 cm at Chilmari, 4 cm at Bahadurabad, 3 cm at Serajganj and 4 cm at Aricha.
- The Buriganga at Dhaka observed rise by 10 cm.
- The Lakhya at Narayanganj observed fall by 4 cm.
- The Dhaleswari at Rekabibazar recorded rise by 4 cm.

GANGES BASIN

- The Ganges-Padma observed rise by 18 cm at Pankha, 23 cm at Rajshahi, 13 cm at Hardinge Bridge, 7 cm at Goalundo and 8 cm at Bhagyakul.
- The Mohananda observed rise by 27 cm at Rohanpur & 18 cm at Chapai-Nawabganj.
- The Gorai at Gorai Rly Bridge recorded rise by 14 cm.

MEGHNA BASIN

- The Surma observed fall by 8 cm at Kanaighat, 1 cm at Sylhet and 15 cm at Sunamganj.
- The Kushiya marked rise by 11 cm at Amalshid, 10 cm at Sheola and 5 cm at Sherpur.
- The Manu recorded rise by 70 cm at Manu Railway BR and 18 cm at Moulvi Bazar.
- The Khowai recorded rise by 37 cm at Ballah while it observed fall by 17 cm at Habiganj.
- The Meghna recorded rise by 9 cm at Bhairab Bazar.
- The Kangsha observed fall by 11 cm at Jariajanjail and still ***is flowing above danger level by 34 cm this morning.***

SOUTH EASTERN HILL BASIN

- The Muhuri at Parshuram recorded fall by 20 cm.
- The Halda at Narayan Hat recorded fall by 115 cm.
- The Matamuhuri registered fall by 85 cm at Lama & 17 cm at Chiringa.
- The river Feni at Ramgarh showed fall by 59 cm.
