RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON JULY 09, 2008.

OUTLOOK

- *No mentionable flood situation prevails over the country. The padma at Bhagyakul is likely to cross danger level by next 24-48 hours, which may not turn to a severe flood situation right now.*
- *All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels except the Kangsha at Jariajanjail.*

RAINFALL

- Significant rainfalls recorded during last 24 hrs. ending at 6 AM today are:
Sunamganj: 60.0 mm, Lorergarh: 75.5 mm, Madaripur: 37.3 mm, Jessore: 34.2 mm.

GENERAL RIVER CONDITION

- Water Level stations: 73, ***Above danger level:1***, Rise: 36, Fall: 36, Steady: 1, Not reported: 0
- The rivers in the Brahmaputra & the Ganges basin observed mostly rise while the rivers in the Meghna & the South Eastern Hill basin observed mostly fall.

BRAHMAPUTRA BASIN

- The Dharla at Kurigram observed fall by 11 cm.
- The Teesta at Dalia observed fall by 30 cm.
- The Brahmaputra-Jamuna recorded rise by 17 cm at Noonkhawa, 12 cm at Chilmari, 12 cm at Bahadurabad, 15 cm at Serajganj and 12 cm at Aricha.
- The Buriganga at Dhaka observed rise by 8 cm.
- The Lakhya at Narayanganj observed rise by 22 cm.
- The Dhaleswari at Rekabibazar recorded rise by 7 cm.

GANGES BASIN

- The Ganges-Padma observed rise by 10 cm at Pankha, 11 cm at Rajshahi, 12 cm at Hardinge Bridge, 13 cm at Goalundo and 12 cm at Bhagyakul.
- The Mohananda observed rise by 16 cm at Rohanpur & 14 cm at Chapai-Nawabganj.
- The Gorai at Gorai Rly Bridge recorded rise by 10 cm.

MEGHNA BASIN

- The Surma observed fall by 20 cm at Kanaighat, 13 cm at Sylhet and 12 cm at Sunamganj.
- The Kushiya marked fall by 18 cm Amalshid, 11 cm at Sheola while it recorded rise by 1 cm at Sherpur.
- The Manu recorded rise by 34 cm at Manu Railway BR while it remained steady at Moulvi Bazar.
- The Khowai recorded fall by 27 cm at Ballah and 37 cm at Habiganj.
- The Meghna recorded rise by 4 cm at Bhairab Bazar.
- The Kangsha observed fall by 11 cm at Jariajanjail and still ***is flowing above danger level by 11 cm this morning.***

SOUTH EASTERN HILL BASIN

- The Muhuri at Parshuram recorded fall by 4 cm.
- The Halda at Narayan Hat recorded fall by 30 cm.
- The Matamuhuri registered fall by 72 cm at Lama.
- The river Feni at Ramgarh showed fall by 13 cm.
