RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON JULY 10, 2008.

OUTLOOK

- *No mentionable flood situation prevails over the country. The Padma at Bhagyakul is likely to cross danger level by next 24 hours, which may not turn to a severe flood situation right now.*
- *All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels except the Kangsha at Jariajanjail.*

RAINFALL

- Significant rainfalls recorded during last 24 hrs. ending at 6 AM today are:
Chandpur: 75.0 mm, Comilla: 60.3 mm, Dhaka: 53.8 mm, Sunamganj: 40.0 mm, BairabBazar: 33.5 mm.

GENERAL RIVER CONDITION

- Water Level stations: 73, ***Above danger level:1***, Rise: 40, Fall: 31, Steady: 2, Not reported: 0
- The rivers in the Brahmaputra observed mostly rise, the rivers in the Ganges basin observed both rise & fall, while the rivers in the Meghna & the South Eastern Hill basin observed mostly fall.

BRAHMAPUTRA BASIN

- The Dharla at Kurigram observed fall by 14 cm.
- The Teesta at Dalia observed rise by 14 cm.
- The Brahmaputra-Jamuna recorded rise by 4 cm at Noonkhawa, 4 cm at Chilmari, 16 cm at Bahadurabad, 15 cm at Serajanj and 6 cm at Aricha.
- The Buriganga at Dhaka observed rise by 12 cm.
- The Lakhya at Narayanganj remained steady.
- The Dhaleswari at Rekabibazar recorded rise by 6 cm.

GANGES BASIN

- The Ganges-Padma observed rise by 3 cm at Pankha, 5 cm at Rajshahi, 5 cm at Goalundo & 5 cm at Bhagyakul while it recorded fall by 2 cm at Hardinge Bridge.
- The Mohananda observed rise by 12 cm at Rohanpur & 7 cm at Chapai-Nawabganj.
- The Gorai at Gorai Rly Bridge recorded rise by 3 cm.

MEGHNA BASIN

- The Surma observed fall by 16 cm at Kanaighat, 12 cm at Sylhet and 6 cm at Sunamganj.
- The Kushiya marked fall by 1 cm Amalshid, 5 cm at Sheola while it remained steady at Sherpur.
- The Manu recorded rise by 15 cm at Manu Railway BR & 18 cm at Moulvi Bazar.
- The Khowai recorded fall by 3 cm at Ballah and 29 cm at Habiganj.
- The Meghna recorded rise by 4 cm at Bhairab Bazar.
- The Kangsha observed fall by 8 cm at Jariajanjail and still ***is flowing above danger level by 2 cm this morning.***

SOUTH EASTERN HILL BASIN

- The Muhuri at Parshuram recorded rise by 54 cm.
- The Halda at Narayan Hat recorded rise by 35 cm.
- The Matamuhuri registered fall by 45 cm at Lama.
- The river Feni at Ramgarh showed fall by 20 cm.
