RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON JULY 11, 2008.

OUTLOOK

- *No mentionable flood situation prevails over the country. The Padma at Bhagyakul crossed danger level yesterday afternoon and now is flowing just 2 cm below danger mark.*
- *The Padma at Goalundo also approaching to danger level.*
- *All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels.*

RAINFALL

- Significant rainfalls recorded during last 24 hrs. ending at 6 AM today are:
BairabBazar: 58.4 mm, Lama: 39.5 mm, Sunamganj: 35.0 mm, Durgapur: 30.0 mm.

GENERAL RIVER CONDITION

- Water Level stations: 73, Rise: 34, Fall: 33, Steady: 4, Not reported: 2
- The rivers in the Brahmaputra, the Ganges, the Meghna & the South Eastern Hill basin observed both rise and fall.

BRAHMAPUTRA BASIN

- The Dharla at Kurigram observed fall by 18 cm.
- The Teesta at Dalia observed rise by 16 cm.
- The Brahmaputra-Jamuna recorded fall by 19 cm at Noonkhawa, 14 cm at Chilmari while it observed rise by 3 cm at Bahadurabad, 3 cm at Serajganj and 4 cm at Aricha.
- The Buriganga at Dhaka observed fall by 5 cm.
- The Lakhya at Narayanganj recorded rise by 3 cm .
- The Dhaleswari at Rekabibazar recorded rise by 2 cm.

GANGES BASIN

- The Ganges-Padma remained steady at Pankha, Rajshahi & Hardinge Bridge, while it recorded rise by 6 cm at Goalundo & 3 at Bhagyakul .
- The Mohananda observed rise by 5 cm at Rohanpur & 4 cm at Chapai-Nawabganj.
- The Gorai at Gorai Rly Bridge recorded rise by 2 cm.

MEGHNA BASIN

- The Surma observed fall by 6 cm at Kanaighat, 2 cm at Sylhet and 5 cm at Sunamganj.
- The Kushiara marked rise by 2 cm Amalshid, 5 cm at Sheola & 2 cm Sherpur.
- The Manu recorded fall by 50 cm at Manu Railway BR & 11 cm at Moulvi Bazar.
- The Khowai recorded rise by 4 cm at Ballah while it recorded fall by 17 cm at Habiganj.
- The Meghna recorded rise by 2 cm at Bhairab Bazar.
- The Kangsha observed fall by 5 cm at Jariajanjail.

SOUTH EASTERN HILL BASIN

- The Muhuri at Parshuram recorded fall by 70 cm.
- The Halda at Narayan Hat recorded rise by 1 cm.
- The Matamuhuri registered fall by 10 cm at Lama.
- The river Feni at Ramgarh showed rise by 15 cm.
