**RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON JULY 12, 2008.**

**OUTLOOK**

- *No mentionable flood situation prevails over the country.*
- *All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels.*

**RAINFALL**

- Significant rainfalls recorded during last 24 hrs. ending at 6 AM today are:  
Kaunia: 125.0 mm, Kurigram: 115.5 mm, Panchpukuria: 107.0 mm, Lorergarh: 103.0 mm, Narayanhat: 85.2 mm, Rohanpur: 85.0 mm & Parshuram: 55.0 mm.

**GENERAL RIVER CONDITION**

- Water Level stations: 73, Rise: 37, Fall: 30, Steady: 07, Not reported: 0.
- The rivers in the Brahmaputra, the Ganges and the Meghna basin observed both rise and fall & most of the river in the South Eastern Hill basin observed rise.

**BRAHMAPUTRA BASIN**

- The Dharla at Kurigram observed fall by 5 cm.
- The Teesta at Dalia observed rise by 22 cm.
- The Brahmaputra-Jamuna recorded fall by 21 cm at Noonkhawa, 19 cm at Chilmari, 23 cm at Bahadurabad, 10 cm at Serajganj and 5 cm at Aricha.
- The Buriganga at Dhaka observed rise by 4 cm.
- The Lakhya at Narayanganj recorded rise by 2 cm.
- The Dhaleswari at Rekabibazar recorded rise by 1 cm.

**GANGES BASIN**

- The Ganges-Padma recorded fall by 4 at Pankha, 1 at Hardinge Bridge & 2 cm at Goalundo while it remained steady at Rajshahi & Bhagyakul .
- The Mohananda observed rise by 4 cm at Chapai-Nawabganj.
- The Gorai at Gorai Rly Bridge remained steady.

**MEGHNA BASIN**

- The Surma observed rise by 63 cm at Kanaighat, 8 cm at Sylhet and 18 cm at Sunamganj.
- The Kushiara observed fall by 22 cm Amalshid, 14 cm at Sheola & 4 cm Sherpur.
- The Manu recorded fall by 38 cm at Manu Railway BR & 17 cm at Moulvi Bazar.
- The Khowai recorded fall by 1cm at Ballah while it recorded rise by 9 cm at Habiganj.
- The Meghna remained steady at Bhairab Bazar.
- The Kangsha observed fall by 13 cm at Jariajanjail.

**SOUTH EASTERN HILL BASIN**

- The Muhuri at Parshuram recorded sharp rise by 172 cm.
- The Halda recorded rise by 144 cm at Narayan Hat & 339 cm at Panchpukuria.
- The Matamuhuri registered rise by 43 cm at Lama.
- The river Feni at Ramgarh showed rise by 52cm.
