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RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON AUGUST 25, 2008.

OUTLOOK

- The overall flood situation of the country is unlikely to deteriorate further.
- The mighty Brahmaputra-Jamuna continued falling and is expected to maintain declining trend for next 2-3 days.
- The Ganges also in mild receding trend and is likely to recede further for next 2-3 days.
- The confluence of both the rivers (the Padma at Goalundo & Bhagyakul) is very likely to start falling from tomorrow.
- Inundation situation in the districts of Munshiganj, Manikganj, Faridpur, Madaripur, Shariatpur, Dohar & Nawabganj of Dhaka district, Shibganj & Sadar of Chapai-Nawabganj district is likely to start improving by next 24-48 hrs. where as flood situation in the district of Sylhet is still deteriorating.
