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RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY AS ON AUGUST 26, 2008.

OUTLOOK

- The mighty Brahmaputra-Jamuna continued falling and is expected to maintain declining trend for next 2-3 days.
- The Ganges observed slight rise at upstream point while it continued receding at downstream points. The river is likely to keep on receding for next 2-3 days.
- The confluence of both the rivers (the Padma at Goalundo & Bhagyakul) is very likely to continue falling for next 2-3 days.
- Inundation situation in the districts of Munshiganj, Manikganj, Faridpur, Madaripur, Shariatpur, Dohar & Nawabganj of Dhaka district, Shibganj & Sadar of Chapai-Nawabganj district is likely to improve further whereas flood situation in the district of Sylhet is still deteriorating.
