Situation Report As of September 11, 2006.

Scenario, Water Logging:

Water logging situation in Keshabpur, Monirampur and Abhoynagar upazila noticed remain same as rainfall again and the volume of discharge added with the current situation. GoB has distributed a total of GR 300 MT of rice and Tk. 3,00,000 for the affected people through the upazila administration of the Jessore district. Recently on September 10, 2006 Jessore district has received additional allocation of VGF for the month of September '06 of 20100 cards for the water logger affected people in Jessore district. The details are shown below:

District administration has also informed the upazila administration for next course of action accordingly.

UNICEF has provided 5500 Pcs of Plastic sheets among the 5500 families for shelter construction purposes in the above-mentioned upazilas. Islamic Relief, Oxfam, Red Crescent, Action Aid, OXFAM-GF, Shushilan, Uttaran, & IDO have also involved to assist the affected people by the water logging. As per the DRRO and NGO officials still the assistance is not adequate for the affected people for their survival because they could not harvest crop for last two years, no poultry, less opportunity of income, and even rice in their house. They could not meet their daily requirement and they want permanent solution of the situation.

GoB has distributed a total 75 MT of rice as GR among the water logged people of Kalaroa (35 MTs) and Tala (40 MTs) upazila under Satkhira district. They have also received additional 6000 VGF cards for the water logged affected people for the month of September '06. The details are shown below:

District administration has also informed the upazila administration for next course of action accordingly. The over all situation of Satkhira is improving.

The situation of Dumuria upazila under Khulna district is deteriorating due to heavy rainfall for last couple of days in that area. They have distributed a total of 7 MTs of rice as GR to the 700 affected families. NGO, Proshika has also distributed food package of 15 kg. Containing Rice, Pulse, oil etc. to the 1000 families. They also receive addition allocation of 5000 VGF cards for 6 affected unions for the month of September '06.
