Date : Septembere 10,2008

Floodwater in different points the river of Brommahputra, Teesta and Ghagot has been gradually decreasing for last three days in Gaibandha district. However, floodwater in some points of the Brommahputra River is still blowing over.06 cm above the danger level. We hope this level of water will be below the danger level within 24 hours. Sufferings of the affected people are not lessened yet flood situation as a whole is improved. The local communication in some affected areas are disrupted. Consequently people have to face many difficulties for communication. The overall situation of health and sanitation is going to worsening, as people's livings places are fully muddy now. Al most all seedbeds, *Amon* crops field and vegetables are damaged. Now the weather is fair and there is no rain at present.
